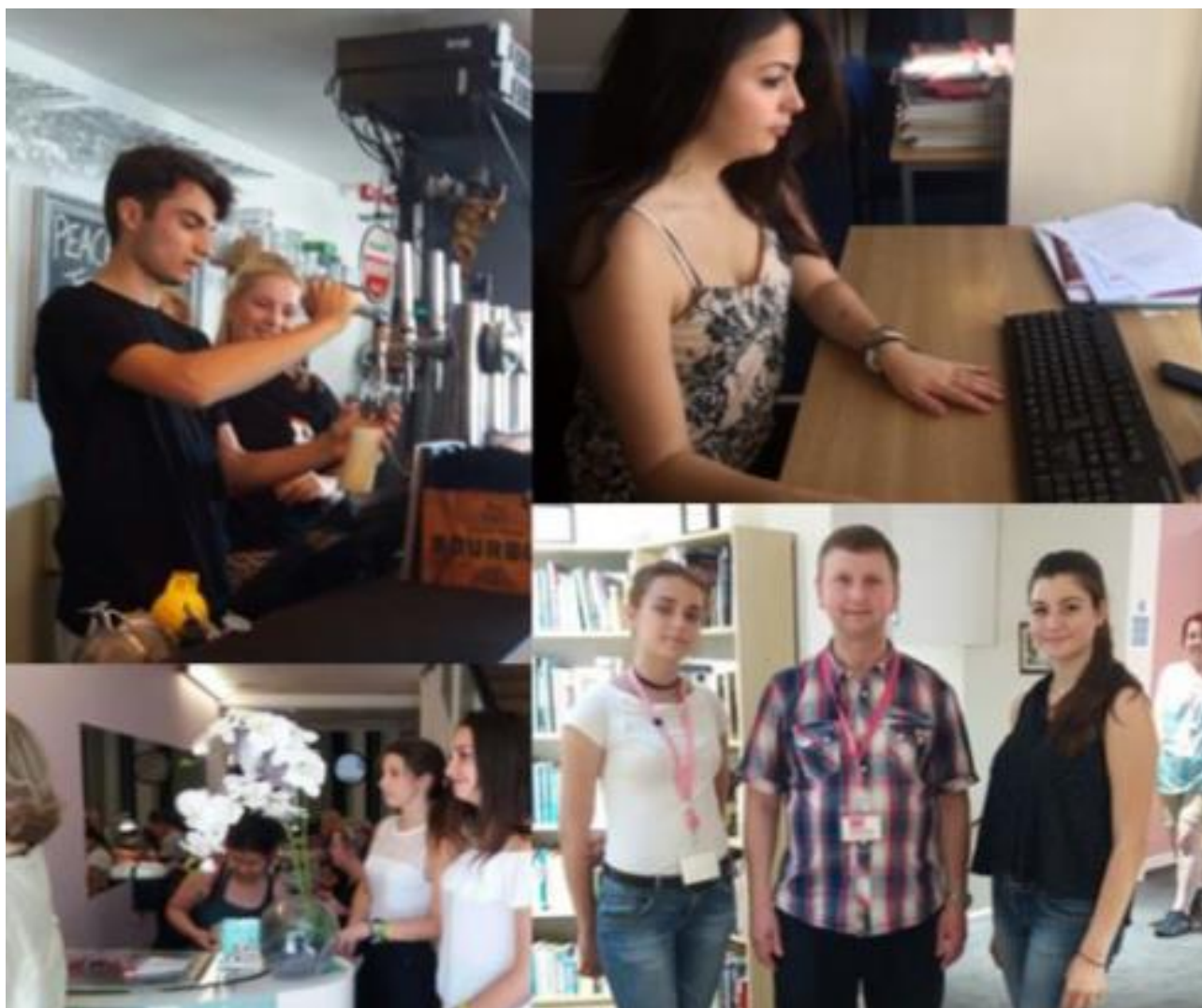

English Work Experience Placement Details

Thank you for your interest in our work experience course. We offer a range of placements with local businesses in and around the town centre, providing you with the perfect opportunity to practice your English in an informal setting. To take part in the course you will need: enthusiasm, willingness to use your English (you must score a minimum of 60/100 on our pre-arrival test) and a smile!

These are some of the popular placements you may be invited to enjoy whilst on your placement in our beautiful town.

What will students be doing?

The roles will vary between each placement

A hospitality role allows a student to over see all aspects of a working hotel; from the restaurant and front of house - meet and greets to room preparations and facility maintenance. A hotel's direct operations can include; servers, housekeepers, porters, kitchen workers, bartenders, management, marketing, and human resources etc. Attractions – students will have fun maintaining the cleanliness of the activity venues - the roller rink and play area, attending to customer needs by serving in the bistro and having a play (depending on how daring/ confident they are!).

- 16 hours per week General English (mornings or afternoons)
- Voluntary work experience placement with a local business
- Typical placements include shops, cafes, bars, restaurants, charity shops, offices, auctioneers, hotels, hair and nail salons.
- Includes the BLS adult social programme (pay as you go)
